In crochet, abbreviations can vary slightly depending on region in the world, primarily US vs. UK.

Even with these differences, there are many terms and abbreviations that are similar. Over the next few pages, I will list the abbreviations I have come across while crafting

There are 5 styles (holds) of knitting. As you come across patterns you may come across them:

- English Knitting (Throwing)
- Continental Knitting (Picking)
- Lever Knitting (Flicking)
- Portuguese Knitting
- Shetland Knitting

There are 3 methods (how you form stitches)

- Eastern
- Western
- Combination Knitting

sssk slip three stitches knitwise, knit these three stitches together through back loops; double left-leaning decrease.

sssp slip three stitches knitwise return these three stitches to left needle and purl these three stitches together through back loops (double left leaning dec)

S2KP2 slip two stitches as if to knit together, knit one, pass 2 slipped stitches over knit stitch; centered double decrease.

SSPP2 slip two stitches knitwise, return these two stitches to left needle and then slip them as if to p2tog through back loops, purl one, pass two slipped stitches over purl stitch centered double decrease.

st stitch

St st stockinette stitch

tbl through back loop tfl through front loop tog together

w&t wrap and turn

WS wrong side

wyib with yarn in back

wyif with yarn in front
